In Calendar Year 2023, the Recreation Department brought in 3,686 registrations for programming across the town. A 14% increase over registration totals in 2022.

After years of studies, funding rounds, and construction, Kallander Field was officially reopened for use by the general public and youth sports! The field's new drainage system and general upgrades have proven consistently successful and are holding their value.

The Recreation Department, along with generous donations and grant funding, introduced AED's to our most active, outdoor recreational facilities. These life-saving devices are accessible at Depietri Field, Richardson Tennis Courts, Neary Field, Trottier Track and Field, 9/11 Memorial Field, and Woodward/Choate Fields.
