Sidewalks at Stockwell & Fitzgerald

Newport Construction began work on the sidewalks within Stockwell and Fitzgerald Lanes on April 16, 2024. We expect the work to take several weeks as it will include (1) removal of existing paving (2) surgical pruning of tree roots by subcontractor: Bartlett Tree, and (3) excavation of existing base gravel and (4) placing new paving. We are working to minimize your disruption, but please be aware there may be several weeks where sidewalks are inaccessible and may have exposed gravel. This may occur at driveway crossing locations as well. Any questions or complaints should be directed to my attention at the contact information below.
