


Online Zoning Request

Building Commissioner Chris Lund has been working to streamline zoning requests and questions through our ViewPoint portal. Historically, the process has been a bit arduous.

Now, requests are streamlined through the Town's permit portal where the Building Commissioner and Town Planner can easily communicate with each other and the applicant. You will see this option on the bottom of the permit list as shown to the right.

The Town of Southborough has been awarded \$6400 from the State of Massachusetts via the Mass Cultural Council to be directed toward projects serving residents of the Town of Southborough through arts and cultural programming in the year ahead. Here are a few fast facts about this year's grant cycle:

- Applications open on September 1st and close on October 17th
- Awards will be made between \$250-~\$1000 for eligible projects
- Based on input from this year's community survey, we encourage particular projects focused on serving:
 - Families with children
 - Senior citizens
- Applicants do not need to be a registered 501(c)3, organization, or institution to apply. Individual artists and groups are encouraged to put forward their applications
