Community Power Choice

Southborough Community Power Choice is a Town electricity supply program that gives residents and businesses more choice and control over how we power our community. The program is a group electricity buying program that changes the electricity supply price on your National Grid electric bill. More than 200 other cities and towns in Massachusetts have similar programs.

Southborough Community Power Choice has three options. Choose the one that's right for you.

New electricity accounts will be automatically enrolled in Power Choice Standard (13.06 cents/kWh).

Power Choice Greener (13.886 cents/kWh) and Power Choice Greenest (15.886 cents/kWh) are available by request. Call 1-833-272-9591 for more info! If you are already enrolled, you do not need to take any action. You will continue to be part of Power Choice.



Narcan Training at the Library

In collaboration with the Board of Health and Greater Boroughs Partnership for Health: Narcan is the brand name of the generic naloxone and is a life-saving medication that can reverse an overdose from opioids when given in time. This free Narcan training, Tuesday, November 19th from 6:00—6:30 PM, will provide participants with a brief lesson on how to recognize an opioid overdose, when and how to use Narcan, and a free kit to take home. MBTA Fare Program

On September 4, 2024, the MBTA launched its Income-eligible Fare Program, which provides residents aged 18-64 who are low-income, the opportunity to ride the T, the RIDE, buses, and commuter rail for approximately 50% off the normal fare price. Coinciding with the launch of the program, the MBTA also put out an outreach toolkit to support community leaders and officials with informing their residents about this program.
