ARPA Project List

As the Town of Southborough completes some big projects thanks to ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) funding, we'd love to start highlighting the opportunities we took to make enhancements and upgrades to the Town. Below find some highlights of how we took advantage of this economic stimulus package:

- We contributed \$27,000 to Taxation Aid. Since 2002 the Town has been backing funds to help offset tax burdens for elderly and disabled residents. Taxation Aid is an important commitment the Town has made to ensure that those experiencing hardships feel less alone and supported by the Town they love. The addition of these monies was a beneficial use of ARPA funds.
- The Town invested ARPA monies into ADA upgrades to town buildings and the Recreation facilities including upgraded doorhandles and handrails. These updates will make the facilities taxpayers frequent more accessible and safe.

A Job Well Done!

A huge congratulations and thank you to Detective Owen O'Brien for his work keeping Southborough's Streets safe! He has been very proactive in identifying and arresting motorists operating under the influence. Last year he made over 45 OUI arrests. His impressive work inspired Lt. Mike Whelan to nominate him as a candidate for the Massachusetts Annual MADD (Mothers Against Drunk Driving) Award, in recognition of his hard work and dedication. We are very happy and proud to report that Detective O'Brien has been selected to receive the Massachusetts's Chapter of MADD's highest Annual Law Enforcement Award- "Officer of the Year."
